Medication Safety

While on the trip the directors and staff of Camp High Places will act “in loco parentis” and as such they will try to ensure that your child is comfortable, safe and happy which may require offering your child some medication if they and the directors of Camp High Places deem it necessary. We sometimes feel it necessary to offer your child some medications just as a parent might. The following medications may be stocked and used on a Camp High Places trip, and are used to manage illness or injury. Cross out those, which your camper should not be given (by not crossing a medication out you are indicating that it is safe to administer this medication to your child to help them be more comfortable):

Acetaminophen (Tylenol)	Aleve	Aloe Vera After Sun
